Please make sure your child is restrained coming to and from Country Kidz.

Under New Zealand law, all children aged under 7 years must be in a car seat that's appropriate for their age and size. They must not travel in the vehicle if you can't put them in an approved child restraint. This provides the best protection in a car crash, because the vehicle safety belt on its own doesn't protect a small child.

Red Light (CPF) Mitigations.

With public health measures in place, we can still offer education and care.

When coming into the centre please make sure you:

- wear a mask
- social distance
- have good basic hygiene
- scan our QR code

We also ask that non essential visitors (including school age children) do not come into the centre and only one parent or caregiver picks up/drops off at a time.
